



# Cresap Rifle Club - Range Rules

**ALWAYS ASK A RANGE OFFICER FIRST WHEN IN DOUBT!**

## **The following actions and / or behaviors are required at all times**

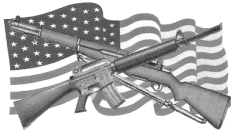
- All federal, state and local laws must be observed
- Keep your finger off of the trigger until ready to fire
- Firearms must be cased or uncased on the shooting bench with the muzzle pointed downrange
- While at the bench the muzzle must always be pointed down range
- Black powder firearms must be capped only while pointed down range
- Hearing and eye protection must be worn at all times
- Rifle cases are only to be stored between the rifle benches or in the ready racks, while on the pistol line rifles must be in the read rack
- Handgun shooters, bring your muzzle up on the target, not down on the target
- Shoot only at targets whose numbers correspond to your bench number
- Children must be supervised by an adult at all times
- All firearms and ammunition must be in safe and working order
- Firearms may be inspected by range officers at anytime

## **Rules for proper firearm handling while at the range**

- All unattended firearms must be unloaded and have the actions open
- All magazines shall be removed from firearms while not in use
- Muzzles must be pointing up and the action open when moving a firearm

## **Rules to be followed during a cease fire**

- Handling of firearms and personal items is strictly prohibited
- Targets and brass may be retrieved to the left of the shooting benches
- In the event of an EMERGENCY anyone can call a cease fire

# **Cresap Rifle Club - Range Rules**

<b>The following are actions and behaviors that are strictly PROHIBITED</b>
---

- No concealed or holstered firearms on the range, this includes off-duty law enforcement
- No suppressed firearms are permitted on the range
- No centerfire rifles chambered for .50 caliber or larger are allowed
- No fully automatic firearms are permitted
- No reckless or rapid fire - all shots must be controlled
- No smoking on the firing line
- No alcohol, illegal drugs, or persons under the influence are permitted on the range
- No more than two people at any shooting position at any one time
- Only scoped pistols are permitted at the rifle benches
- No rifles are permitted on the pistol benches
- No intentional destruction of range property will be tolerated
- No standing or off hand shooting from the rifle benches is allowed
- No tracer, steel, armor piercing or incendiary ammo may be fired on the range
- Shotguns are slug only.
- No arguing with a range officer
- No gunsmithing at the shooting bench
- No loaded firearms may leave the range
- No loaded firearms are to be pointed above the horizontal marker at any time
- No parking along the road or side entrance. All non members must park in the lower lot
- No entrance through the side MEMBERS ONLY gate unless handicap access is required
